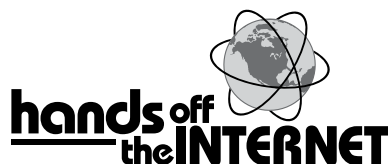
For a generation, the United States has acted with consummate wisdom in keeping the Internet free of regulation.
